- **Institute of Management Studies, Banaras Hindu University (BHU)**

IM-BHU, formerly known as Faculty of Management Studies, BHU (FMS-BHU) is another very old and respected MBA college in the country. It was established in 1968 and stands amongst the oldest business schools in the country. NIRF has ranked IM-BHU as the 28th best business school in the country. It is known for its low fees and a long legacy of quality education.

Admission criteria: It accepts CAT scores for admission.

Cut-off Score: The cutoff generally stands are 80 to 83rd percentile in CAT.

Placements: The average package at the institute is around 7 LPA.
