

NOTIFICATION

In pursuance to the decision taken in the Governing Body of IoE meeting held on 12.08.2023 the following new scheme is being introduced with immediate effect:

'Raja Jwala Prasad Post-Doctoral Fellowship'

The University recognizes the contributions of its faculty members in securing external funding for research projects. To further strengthen their research capabilities, the University proposes the establishment of a 'Raja Jwala Prasad Post-Doctoral Fellowship Program' to encourage and empower such faculty members and to attach highly qualified and motivated young researchers as postdoctoral fellows. This program will also enhance the university's research output and promote collaboration across diverse disciplines. The postdoctoral fellowships will be open to various research areas, spanning disciplines across the university.

Program Objectives:

- Encourage and empower faculty members who have been successful in securing significant external funding.
- Enhance the research capacity and research output of the University by recruiting highly qualified postdoctoral researchers.
- Promote interdisciplinary collaboration across departments and research areas.
- Accelerate the progress of ongoing research projects funded by IoE or external agencies through additional research support.

Fellowship Details:

- The faculty member's externally-funded research project must be ongoing. IoE-funded research projects will not count as 'externally funded'. However, the postdoctoral fellow need not work on the ongoing sponsored research project.
- The postdoctoral fellowships will have a duration of one year subject to the possibility of extension of one more year based on performance and the availability of funds under IoE.
- Postdoctoral fellows will receive a consolidated salary Rs.60,000/pm + HRA (Rs. 10,000) + contingency Rs.50,000/per annum.
- The Fellow will carry the title of "Raja Jwala Prasad Post-Doctoral Fellow".
- Fellows will have access to comprehensive benefits, including health services, library and access to other university resources.

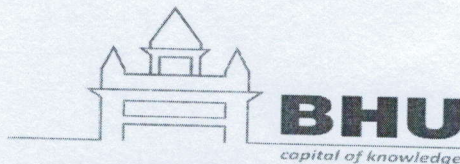
Mentorship and Support:

Such faculty members will act as a mentor and will provide guidance and support to the fellow during their tenure at the university. Their work is expected to be published in SCOPUS indexed journals.

Application Process:

- Faculty members interested in engaging a fellow must submit an expression of interest to the office of SRICC.
- The expression of interest should include details about the faculty member's funded research projects in the last 5 years, and the postdoctoral position's scope. A committee will review the request and make recommendation to the Vice Chancellor for sanction of funds for postdoctoral fellowship from IoE.
- The selection of postdoctoral fellow should be made as per project guidelines 2018.
- The faculty member will be responsible for initiating the recruitment process for the postdoctoral fellow in coordination with the office of SRICC.
