
Applications are invited, for the post of a **Junior Research Fellow (JRF) (01)** with fixed emolument of Rs. 31,000/- per month plus 18% HRA in an ICMR-sponsored Project (**P-14/0783**) entitled “**Assessing the transgenerational impact of unpredictable stress on germ cell dynamics and sexual cognition of male**” using mice as an animal model. The post is temporary, with a three-year term, and co-terminus with the project.

Essential Qualifications: The candidate should hold a Master's degree in Zoology/Life Sciences/ Biotechnology/Biochemistry/ Molecular and Human Genetics, with 55% marks from a recognized University. The candidate should have qualified NET/GATE.
