Finally, in 1978 Fine Arts unit was bifurcated and > Last date of registration: formed the Faculty of Visual Arts. Later on research degree was also introduced. Presently Department of Painting is the largest > Registration link: department of the faculty having 3 sections (Textile Design, Print Making & Mural), 10 regular faculty members and 28 research scholars.
